GENERAL INFORMATION

A group of keen dog trainers have come together to organise the first Working Dog Auction in South Australia in conjunction with the Lucindale Lions Club.

We will be hosting the Inaugural Lucindale Working Dog Auction on the 26th of September 2021 at Yakka Park, Lucindale - the home of the South East Field Days.

The Auction is a non-for-profit event and funds raised will go back to the local community. The Auction will be run by Elders in conjunction with AuctionsPlus including a live stream on the day.

Live dog demonstrations will start at in the morning and the Auction will begin after lunch.

We are aiming to sell 40 dogs and 5 pups (aged 4-9 months).

The event will be fully catered and completely under cover.

- Read the terms and conditions of entry carefully
- Complete an entry form. (One entry form for each dog)
- Return entry form and payment to the value of \$100 per dog entered.

Non refundable once the dog is accepted into the sale.

VIDEO OF THE DOG

- 1) We require a basic video of your dog working to be sent with your entry form to help the Lucindale Working Dog Auction Committee with our auction preparation. This video is for our committee only not your YouTube sale video.
- 2) We strongly recommend a YouTube video be sent through for greatest exposure of your dog pre-sale and to add to the AuctionsPlus catalogue.
Email your YouTube video link before 12th September it will be shared on the Lucindale Working Dog Auction Facebook page and the AuctionsPlus website.

ANIMAL REQUIREMENTS

- Current Vet's vaccination certificate needs to be presented prior to auction (or returned with entry)
- The dog must be in a healthy condition.

South Australian sellers must supply:

- Dogs and Cats Online (DACO) breeder registration number.
- Microchipping is compulsory – name & address of who microchipped the dog, the date the procedure was done, the microchip number & details of registry where the microchip number is stored.
- Details of any known illness or medical condition that the dog has.
- Any control order on the dog (i.e. destruction, dangerous, menacing, nuisance, barking).

Victorian sellers must supply:

- Animal Welfare Victoria Breeder source number generated by the Pet Exchange Register.
- Microchipping is compulsory – name & address of who microchipped the dog, the date the procedure was done, the microchip number & details of registry where the microchip number is stored.
- Details of any know illness or medical condition that the dog has.
- Any control order on the dog (i.e. destruction, dangerous, menacing, nuisance, barking).

Other States:

- You will need to have either a DACO breeder registration number with Dogs and Cats Online www.dogsandcatsonline.com.au or a Breeder source number per@agriculture.vic.gov.au prior to the sale.
